•	The Jewish council wanted Jesus crucified because of blasphemy (Jesus claimed to be God). Pilate would not have authorized the crucifixion because of blasphemy.

•	Scourging was done to accelerate the death. The scourging was so intense that some criminals died before the crucifixion.

•	Placing Jesus in-between two criminals made Him out to be the vilest of the group.
